£1m boost to Wellington Monument's future in Autumn Statement

A £1 million grant has been awarded towards urgent repairs of the Wellington Monument by Chan-cellor Philip Hammond's in his first Autumn Statement earlier today.

The money comes from fines levied on the banking industry for manipulating the LIBOR rate. Today the government committed £102 million over the next 4 years to support good causes – with £1 million going to the repairs of the Wellington Monument.

This funding gives the project a huge boost. The next step is the National Trust has submitted their application to the Heritage Lottery Fund towards the £2 million still needed to raise for the project to go ahead. The Trust would like to thank the "monument champions" of which your Parish Chair John Greenshields is one, for their hard work surveying the Public's feelings about the project.

Did you see the 'Banksy' style art found on the monument door? It may not have been 'Banksy', but certainly gave the monument some attention!
